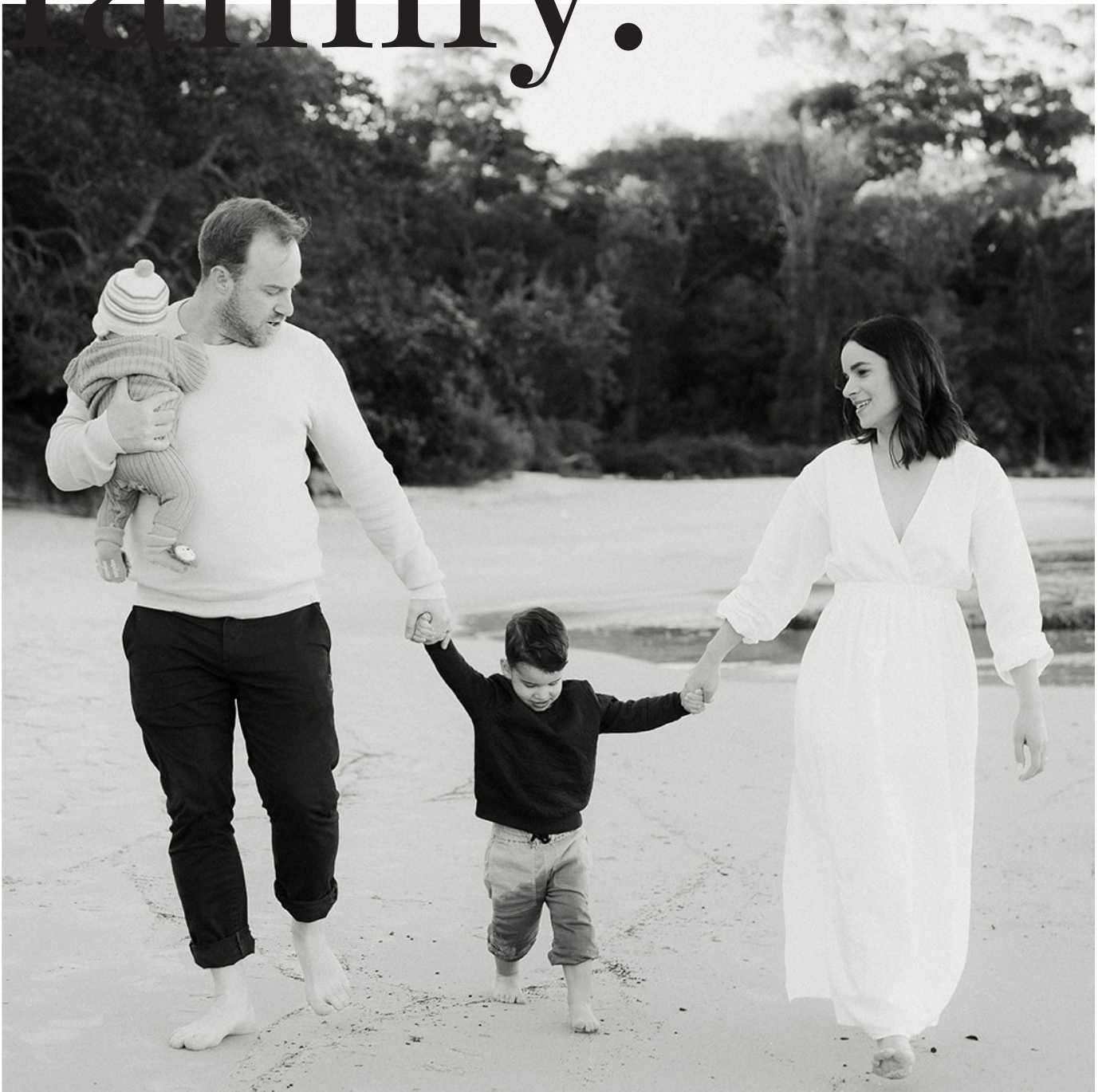

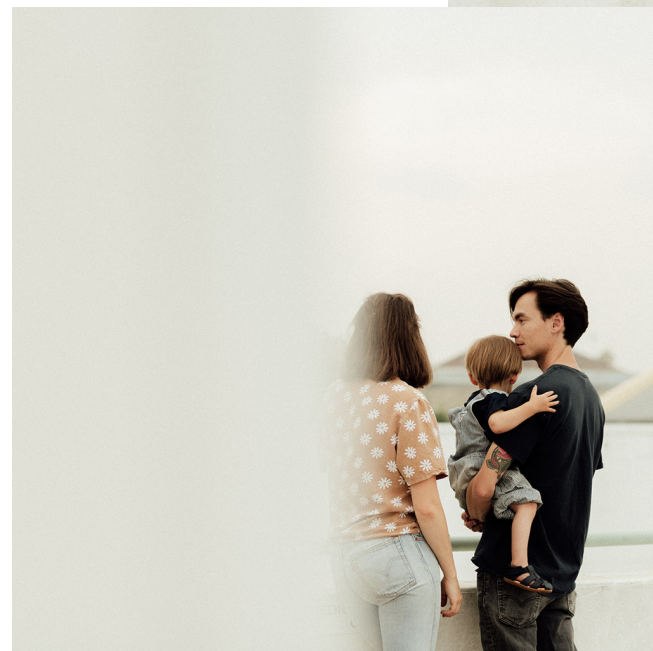

# Photo-shoot Day

*What to wear, what time, how do we organise it, what's the best location?*

*Can you come to us, do we come to you, how long will you stay?*

*All these questions answered here...*

## TIME OF DAY

For outdoor location shoots, I generally always shoot in the late afternoon, ideally leading up to sunset. For those with small children...this can be tricky! But with a little planning and flexibility I find families can usually manage, and you will get superior results, so it's well worth going to the effort! Perhaps a slightly later or longer nap, a later lunch, or an earlier dinner, these tactics can help. I also find the distraction of being in a new place often means littlies don't get as phased by the change in routine that you might expect. For babies, well it's only natural that during the time we shoot they will move through a few stages, from wakeful to sleepy.

## LOCATION

We will discuss possible locations in our consultation call, but it's good to have a think about what kind of spots might suit your family. In the Blue Mountains there's a range of locations to suit a variety of needs. From trickling creeks, to deep swimming holes, amazing excarpement views, and even urban settings. For newborn shoots, it's often easy to arrange a shoot in your home, and then taking a little walk with the bub for a change of scene.



## WHAT TO WEAR

I tend to advise people to wear casual clothes for family photoshoots. There's lots of moving around, walking...perhaps a couple of location changes. I want your photos to truly reflect who you are as a family at whatever stage you're in. One point I do make...I recommend no writing or large clothing labels. However...if this is going to cause issues, or tantrums, or any kind of resentment to the photo-shoot itself, well it's certainly not worth a fight!

Plain neutral colours are timeless, as are knits and natural fibres. Jeans, dresses, really anything goes...as long as you feel comfortable and relaxed. There's no point getting a fancy new outfit if you're going to be unsure if it suits you, and pulling or tugging uncomfortably.

Or wearing a button up shirt if it's not something you would ever wear out with the kids.

Just relax and be yourselves.

- What time is sunset
- What kind of location suits your family
- Do you want couple photos too
- Choose clothes that you can move in
- AND clothes that feel like 'you'
- Which photo combinations are important
- Will there be teenagers?

## General

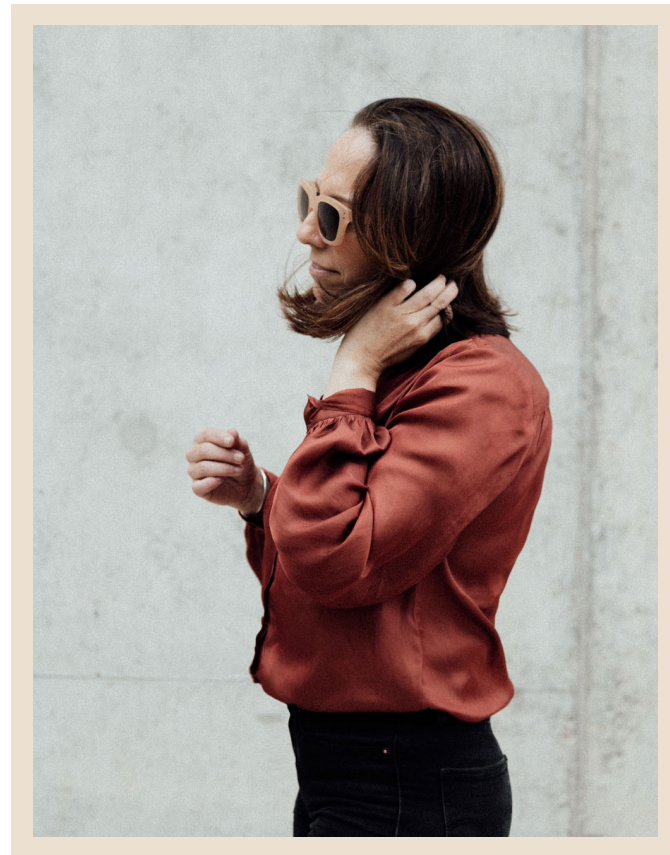
- Is there extra time for babies to feed
- Do you want a 'home' newborn shoot
- Or various locations, can we walk somewhere
- Is your child shy, we can take our time
- Or are they very active, let's entertain them
- How many in the family
- What is the dynamic of siblings
- Do you have a specific location in mind

## Little People

- Talk about the photo-shoot
- Discuss clothing options before the day
- Do you need an early dinner?
- A change of clothes can come in handy, especially for babies AND those who might change their mind on the spot.
- Snacks or treats
- Plan for the car drive, and allow extra time
